



Florida Department of Health in Dixie County will be offering <a href="#FREE">FREE</a> Self-Monitoring Blood Pressure classes beginning in mid-March as part of the Heart Health Plus initiative to address cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and tobacco cessation in Dixie County.

Weekly classes will offer health education on lifestyle changes and techniques such as: smoking cessation, diabetes education/screenings, healthy cooking/eating and more.

- Participants must enroll and complete the 12 week program.
- Participants must be clinically diagnosed with hypertension.
- Participants will receive a free self-monitoring blood pressure machine and much, much more.
